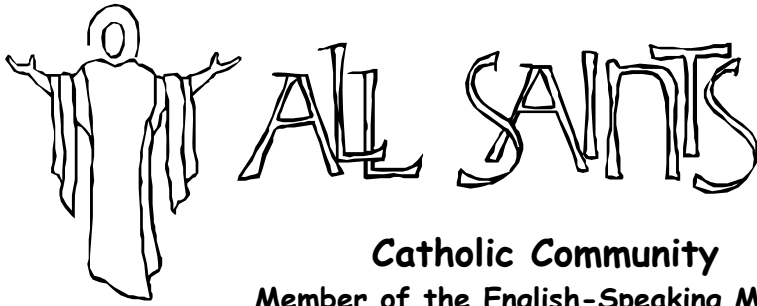

Joshua 5:9-12 • Psalm 34:2-7 • 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 • Luke 15:1-3, 11-32
