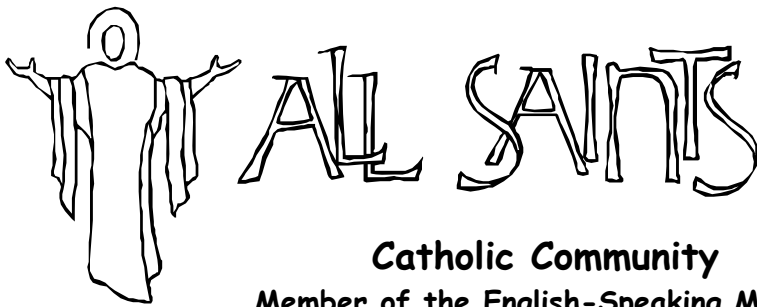

In ancient Greece, *Rhea*, the mother of all Greek goddesses, was honored annually at a springtime feast. In Rome, a raucous spring festival was held to honor the Roman mother goddess, *Cybele*. The first official celebration of mothers in the United States took place in 1858. Anna Reeves Jarvis campaigned for a Mothers' Work Day in West Virginia. In 1914, Mother's Day was recognized as a national holiday by Presidential proclamation. More than sixty countries celebrate Mother's Day together with America on the second Sunday in May. Every September, on Gold Star Mother's Day, Americans honor military mothers who have lost a son or daughter during active duty. Stepmothers in the US have their own special holiday on May 1st.

We, at All Saints, appreciate and thank all the mothers among us, for all their love and commitment, for the way they protect, teach, and nurture their children with all their hearts, strengthen their families and help build a better future for all of us.
