

Sts. Cosmas & Damian

Sts. Cosmas and Damian were twin brothers who lived in the Roman province of Syria. They were skilled in the science of medicine and, as Christians, did not charge a fee for their services and therefore stood in the highest esteem of the people. Emperor Diocletian persecuted Christians. Cosmas and Damian were arrested about the year 283 and tortured into recanting their Christian faith by the Prefect of Cilicia. Despite enduring great suffering, they remained true to their faith and were finally executed. Their younger brothers, Anthimus, Leontius and Euprepus, also shared in their martyrdom. Sts. Cosmas and Damian's most known miraculous healing was the grafting of a leg from a deceased Ethiopian to replace a patient's ulcerated leg. Emperor Justinian built a basilica in their honor in Constantinople in the sixth century. Sts. Cosmas and Damian are patron saints of barbers, pharmacists, physicians and surgeons.
