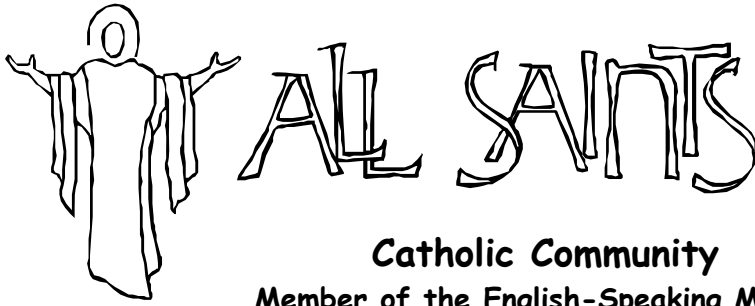

### **Holy Father's prayer intentions for January 2011**

**General Intention:** That the riches of creation be preserved, valued and made available to all, as a precious gifts from God to mankind. • **Missionary Intention:** That Christians may achieve full unity, bearing witness of the universal fatherhood of God to the entire human race.

**Santa Clara**, California, a city in the center of Silicon Valley, is home to many high-tech companies in the computer industry in the US. One of Santa Clara's outstanding establishments is the Santa Clara University (SCU), a Jesuit university offering curricula in arts & sciences, business, engineering, pastoral ministries, counseling psychology, education, theology and law. Founded in 1851 by the Society of Jesus, SCU teaches more than 8,800 students. The Santa Clara de Asis Mission dating back to 1777 was founded by the Franciscans and was the first outpost of Spanish civilization in the Santa Clara Valley. The Mission Church has served as the Santa Clara University chapel, used by the University community for Masses, baptisms, weddings and funerals but it is open to the public and welcomes visitors. Not only is the church a center of Catholic intellectuality, but also a place of flourishing student activity like choir and music ministry and it attracts large numbers of faithful many of whom contribute actively to building and maintaining a spiritual home for those involved in the most diverse activities of the Silicon Valley.
