June 12, 2011 Pentecost Sunday

Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9 • Daniel 3:52-56 • 2 Corinthians 13:11-13 • John 3:16-18

The Paschal Mystery is composed of four inter-related components: the **suffering and death**; the **resurrection**; the **ascension**; and the **sending of the Spirit**. The resurrection states that the crucified Jesus is alive and the ascension proclaims that the risen and living Jesus has entered into close communion with his father thus opening the door to the ministry of the Holy Spirit. The feast of the Ascension does not commemorate a departure, but rather celebrates the living and lasting presence of Jesus in his Church. The following short story illustrates the relationship between God's presence and absence.

Years ago, a fishing fleet went out from a small harbor on the east coast of Newfoundland. In the afternoon there came a great storm. When night settled down, not a single vessel of all the fleet had found its way into the port. All night long, wives, mothers, children and sweethearts paced up and down the beach, wringing their hands and calling on God to save their loved ones. To add to the horror of the situation, one of the cottages caught fire. Since the men were all away, it was impossible to save the home. When the morning broke, to the joy of all, the entire fleet found safe harbor in the bay. But there was one face with a picture of despair – the wife of the man whose home had been destroyed. Meeting her husband as he landed, she cried “*Oh, husband, we are ruined. Our home and all it contained was destroyed by fire.*” But the man exclaimed, “*Thank God for the fire. The interplay between presence and absence may not be understood at the beginning of the story, but as the story progresses, the presence of the Spirit becomes clear similar to the history of humanity and the Church.
