## Confirmation Preparation Continues . . . Did you know

The confirmation class of 6 students continues its preparation begun in September 2018. We ask the All Saints community to hold our students and their families in prayer during this time of preparation for this final sacrament of initiation. The Confirmation mass is scheduled for Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup> at 1400 at St. Elisabeth's Church, Kolonnenstrasse in Schöneberg. All are welcome.

Our confirmation candidates are: Benjamin Ademi; Claire Castellon; Charlotte Görsch; Timothy Pedussel; Merle Vogel and Nisha Wunder.

After an initial study of the Bible timeline, we have been studying all aspects of the church, its liturgical year, the sacraments, the saints, and are now using a Matthew Kelly authored book called, Decision Point. A recent class focused on prayer, its importance, how prayer can make a difference in our lives, and included a 7 step "how to pray" process.

### **What is Confirmation?**

Confirmation is the sacrament that completes Baptism; in it the gift of the Holy Spirit is bestowed upon us. Anyone who freely decides to live a life as God's child and asks for God's Spirit under the signs of the imposition of hands and anointing with chrism receives the strength to witness to God's love and might in word and deed.
