### First Friday Mass and Night Vigil at All-Saints

The English-speaking Mission will celebrate mass the first Friday of the month at 7:00 in the evening, followed by adoration hours during the night.

Between Friday 7pm and 9:30pm All Saints will take charge, followed by St. Bernard until midnight. From 12 to 5 am, St. Elizabeth takes charge.

### First Communion Preparation

Classes for First Holy Communion preparation will start at St. Bernhard's on Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. The office will collect your name and details and provide you with the necessary registration form.
